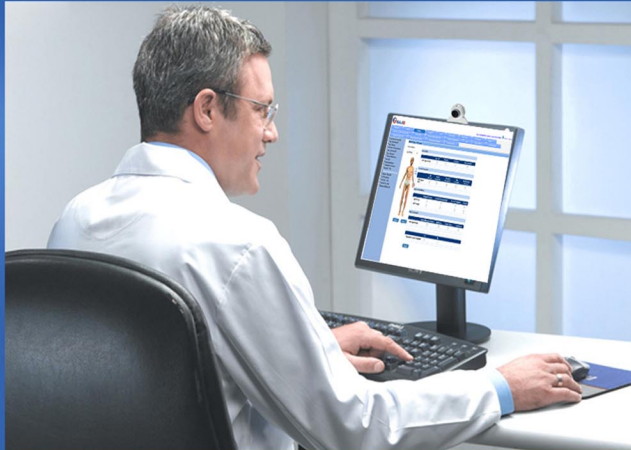


iHelix TELECARE

Specialists can be consulted remotely using video conferencing and transmitting relevant images and patient data for expert opinion.



POST SURGERY CARE

Post surgery treatment can be given virtually where patients can engage in live audio and video encounters.
